

Grow and Glow

Very High energy finisher supplement

- ✓ Grow and Glow is a very cost effective way of fattening stock. Improves muscle definition and growth rates.
- ✓ Is a very high energy supplement, containing up to 10 MJ/kg energy, similar to a finisher ration.
- ✓ Grow and Glow contains no grain with the main ingredient being high quality protein meals such as Full Fat Soy. Is extremely safe to feed with no grain derived issues.
- ✓ Grow and Glow is a self-regulating supplement therefore it does not require monitoring of intakes. It is to be used in a similar fashion to other supplements so that stock will "chase" roughage and they will therefore consume the cheapest feed source i.e. pasture.
- ✓ Is extremely cost effective for backgrounding young stock. Young stock respond to higher quality protein such as bypass protein (protein meals) and therefore high growth rates can be achieved.
- ✓ Trials have shown growth rates of 0.4 – 0.6 kg / head/ day in winter on dry frosted feed.
- ✓ Is the best product to use when feeding oats or lush green feed. It is designed to minimise scouring and balance the high protein green feed with high energy and fibre. The mineral content is formulated to aid in the control of "oat and grass tetany".
- ✓ Is ideal to be fed to young bulls or bulls on oats. It is designed with fertility in mind and promotes a clean, shiny coat.
- ✓ Stock supplemented with Grow and Glow can be sold as "Paddock Reared".

Feeding guide

- Intake when on Green Pasture 100 to 800 grams / head / day.
- Intake when on Dry Pasture 400 to 1500 grams / head / day.
- Introduce gradually and start on 4% Urea or below.
- Do not feed to hungry or starving stock.
- Feed in dry trough and keep protected from the weather.
- Feed intake can be restricted by the use of DCP or salt.
- Contains Monensin for improvement in feed conversion and to aid in bloat control.
